EXHIBIT "A"

Beginning at a point on the North right of way of Highway 54 that is 230 feet West of the East line of Section 20, Township 27 South, Range 4 East of the 6th P.M.; thence West 709.9 feet; thence South 25 feet; thence West 1187.48 feet to a point that is 538 feet East of the West line said Southeast Quarter; thence North 225 feet to the center line of Dry Creek; thence Easterly along the center line of Dry Creek to a point 230 feet West of the East line of said Southeast Quarter; thence South 220.13 feet to the point of beginning, Butler County, Kansas.

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Requirements

All of the following Requirements must be met:

- 1. The Proposed Insured must notify the Company in writing of the name of any party not referred to in this Commitment who will obtain an interest in the Land or who will make a loan on the Land. The Company may then make additional Requirements or Exceptions.
- 2. Pay the agreed amount for the estate or interest to be insured.
- 3. Pay the premiums, fees, and charges for the Policy to the Company.
- 4. Documents satisfactory to the Company that convey the Title or create the Mortgage to be insured, or both, must be properly authorized, executed, delivered, and recorded in the Public Records.
- 5. FURNISH executed Owner's Affidavit and Certification as prescribed by the Company.
- 6. Record Warranty Deed from R. Eugene Dennett and Carol J Dennett, and stating marital status, to Purchaser with contractual rights under a purchase agreement with the vested owner identified at Item 4, together with Kansas Real Estate Validation Questionnaire fully completed and signed to accompany said Deed.
- 7. For each policy to be issued as identified in Schedule A, Item 2; the Company shall not be liable under this commitment until it receives a designation for a Proposed Insured, acceptable to the Company. As provided in Commitment Condition 4, the Company may amend this commitment to add, among other things, additional exceptions or requirements after the designation of the Proposed Insured.
- 8. The Company requires a copy of the fully executed sales contract setting forth the names of all parties and the sales price of the subject property and this commitment must be updated to show any additional exceptions and/or requirements prior to closing.

**NOTE: The actual value of the estate or interest to be insured must be disclosed to the Company, and subject to approval by the Company, entered as the amount of the policy to be issued. It is agreed that, as between the Company, the applicant for this commitment, and every person relying on this commitment, the amount of the requested policy will be assumed to be \$1,000.00, and the total liability of the Company on account of this commitment shall not exceed that amount, until such time as the actual amount of the policy to be issued shall have been agreed upon and entered as aforesaid, and the Company's applicable insurance premium charges for same shall have been paid.

THIS COMMITMENT DOES NOT REPUBLISH ANY COVENANT, CONDITION, RESTRICTION, OR LIMITATION CONTAINED IN ANY DOCUMENT REFERRED TO IN THIS COMMITMENT TO THE EXTENT THAT THE SPECIFIC COVENANT, CONDITION, RESTRICTION, OR LIMITATION VIOLATES STATE OR FEDERAL LAW BASED ON RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, HANDICAP, FAMILIAL STATUS, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.

The Policy will not insure against loss or damage resulting from the terms and provisions of any lease or easement identified in Schedule A, and will include the following Exceptions unless cleared to the satisfaction of the Company:

- 1. Any defect, lien, encumbrance, adverse claim, or other matter that appears for the first time in the Public Records or is created, attaches, or is disclosed between the Commitment Date and the date on which all of the Schedule B, Part I-Requirements are met.
- 2. Rights or claims of parties in possession not shown by the public records
- 3. Easements or claims of easements, not shown by the public records.
- 4. Any encroachment, encumbrance, violation, variation, or adverse circumstance affecting the Title that would be disclosed by an accurate and complete land survey of the Land or that could be ascertained by and inspection of the Land.
- 5. Any lien or right to a lien, for services, labor, or material heretofore or hereafter furnished, imposed by law and not shown by the public records.
- 6. Taxes or special assessments which are not shown as existing liens by the public records.
- 7. General and special taxes for the year 2019 and subsequent years.

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COMMITMENT CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS 1.

- "Knowledge" or "Known": Actual or imputed knowledge, but not constructive notice imparted by the (a)
- "Land": The land described in Schedule A and affixed improvements that by law constitute real (b) property. The term "Land" does not include any property beyond the lines of the area described in Schedule A, nor any right, title, interest, estate, or easement in abutting streets, roads, avenues, alleys, lanes, ways, or waterways, but this does not modify or limit the extent that a right of access to and from the Land is to be insured by the Policy.
- "Mortgage": A mortgage, deed of trust, or other security instrument, including one evidenced by (c) electronic means authorized by law.
- "Policy": Each contract of title insurance, in a form adopted by the American Land Title (d) Association, issued or to be issued by the Company pursuant to this Commitment.
- "Proposed Insured": Each person identified in Schedule A as the Proposed Insured of each Policy (e) to be issued pursuant to this Commitment.
- "Proposed Policy Amount": Each dollar amount specified in Schedule A as the Proposed Policy (f) Amount of each Policy to be issued pursuant to this Commitment.
- "Public Records": Records established under state statutes at the Commitment Date for the (g) purpose of imparting constructive notice of matters relating to real property to purchasers for value and without Knowledge.
- "Title": The estate or interest described in Schedule A. (h)
- If all of the Schedule B, Part I-Requirements have not been met within the time period specified in the 2. Commitment to Issue Policy, this Commitment terminates and the Company's liability and obligation end.
- The Company's liability and obligation is limited by and this Commitment is not valid without: 3.

 - the Commitment Conditions; (c)

 - Schedule B, Part I—Requirements; and Schedule B, Part II—Exceptions; and (e)

COMPANY'S RIGHT TO AMEND 4.

The Company may amend this Commitment at any time. If the Company amends this Commitment to add a defect, lien, encumbrance, adverse claim, or other matter recorded in the Public Records prior to the Commitment Date, any liability of the Company is limited by Commitment Condition 5. The Company shall not be liable for any other amendment to this Commitment.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY 5.

- The Company's liability under Commitment Condition 4 is limited to the Proposed Insured's actual (a) expense incurred in the interval between the Company's delivery to the Proposed Insured of the Commitment and the delivery of the amended Commitment, resulting from the Proposed Insured's good faith reliance to:
 - comply with the Schedule B, Part I-Requirements; (i)
 - eliminate, with the Company's written consent, any Schedule B, Part II-Exceptions; or (ii)
 - acquire the Title or create the Mortgage covered by this Commitment. (iii)
- The Company shall not be liable under Commitment Condition 5(a) if the Proposed Insured (b) requested the amendment or had Knowledge of the matter and did not notify the Company about it in writing.

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- (c) The Company will only have liability under Commitment Condition 4 if the Proposed Insured would not have incurred the expense had the Commitment included the added matter when the Commitment was first delivered to the Proposed Insured.
- (d) The Company's liability shall not exceed the lesser of the Proposed Insured's actual expense incurred in good faith and described in Commitment Conditions 5(a)(i) through 5(a)(iii) or the Proposed Policy Amount.
- (e) The Company shall not be liable for the content of the Transaction Identification Data, if any.
- In no event shall the Company be obligated to issue the Policy referred to in this Commitment unless all of the Schedule B, Part I—Requirements have been met to the satisfaction of the Company.
- (g) In any event, the Company's liability is limited by the terms and provisions of the Policy.

6. LIABILITY OF THE COMPANY MUST BE BASED ON THIS COMMITMENT

- (a) Only a Proposed Insured identified in Schedule A, and no other person, may make a claim under this Commitment.
- (b) Any claim must be based in contract and must be restricted solely to the terms and provisions of this Commitment.
- (c) Until the Policy is issued, this Commitment, as last revised, is the exclusive and entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this Commitment and supersedes all prior commitment negotiations, representations, and proposals of any kind, whether written or oral, express or implied, relating to the subject matter of this Commitment.
- (d) The deletion or modification of any Schedule B, Part II—Exception does not constitute an agreement or obligation to provide coverage beyond the terms and provisions of this Commitment or the Policy.
- (e) Any amendment or endorsement to this Commitment must be in writing and authenticated by a person authorized by the Company.
- (f) When the Policy is issued, all liability and obligation under this Commitment will end and the Company's only liability will be under the Policy.

7. IF THIS COMMITMENT HAS BEEN ISSUED BY AN ISSUING AGENT

The issuing agent is the Company's agent only for the limited purpose of issuing title insurance commitments and policies. The issuing agent is not the Company's agent for the purpose of providing closing or settlement services.

8. PRO-FORMA POLICY

The Company may provide, at the request of a Proposed Insured, a pro-forma policy illustrating the coverage that the Company may provide. A pro-forma policy neither reflects the status of Title at the time that the pro-forma policy is delivered to a Proposed Insured, nor is it a commitment to insure.

9. ARBITRATION

The Policy contains an arbitration clause. All arbitrable matters when the Proposed Policy Amount is \$2,000,000 or less shall be arbitrated at the option of either the Company or the Proposed Insured as the exclusive remedy of the parties.
