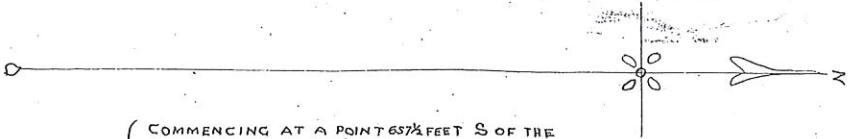


SHELDEN'S ADDITION

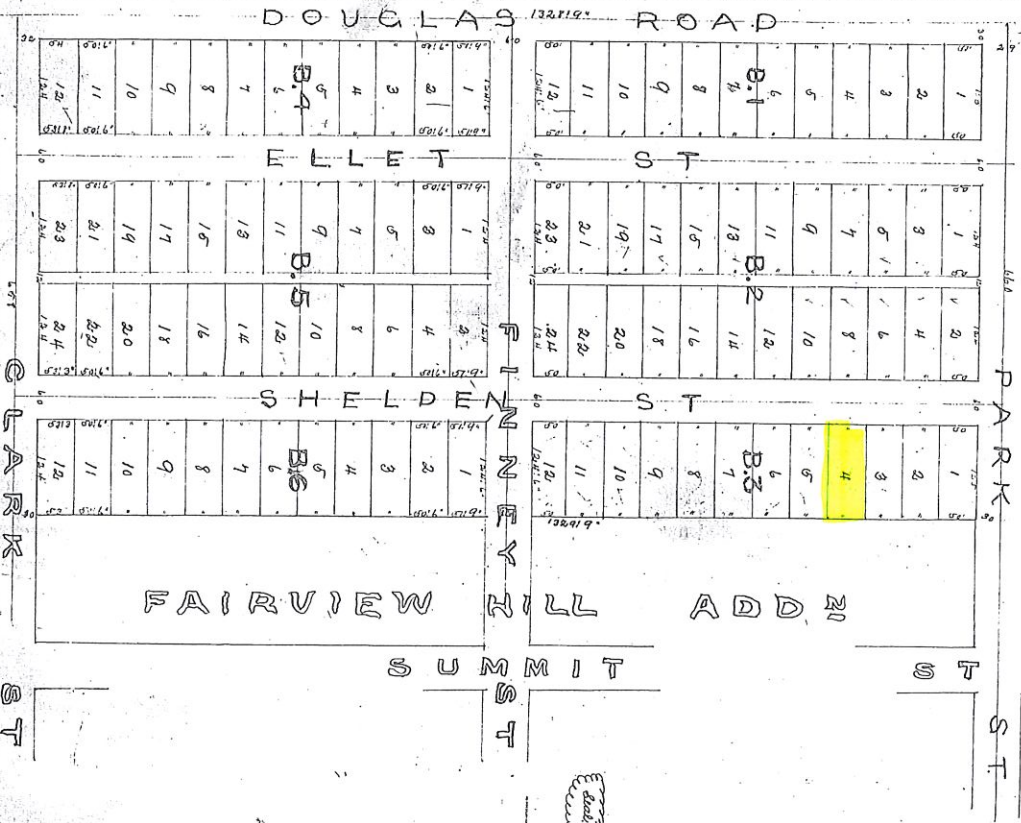
