Black walnut trees - planted for veneer harvest, furniture, walnuts & habitat

Pecan tree - nuts

Lodi apple trees - planted for their exceptional applesauce & pies

Red Delicious apple trees - eating

Jonathan apples - planted for cider, cakes, pies

Bartlett pears - an eating & baking pear

Bosc pear - planted for baking/cooking

Hickory - furniture

Hackberry - steam bending, berries for wildlife

Wild Plum - jam

Silver Maple - planted for veneer harvest, furniture

Pin oak - fuel wood, shade tree (quick growing)

Flowering crabapple - ornamental & bird habitat

American elm - furniture & shade

Honey locust - the best firewood, furniture

Hedge trees - fence posts, firewood

Mulberry trees - jam

Eastern Red Cedar- wildlife plantings/shelterbelts, furniture

Cottonwood - wildlife habitat
