

MEMORANDUM OF TRANSFER AND CONTRIBUTION OF  
TELECOMMUNICATION RIGHTS

WHEREAS, by virtue of a certain Telecommunication Rights Agreement (hereafter the "Agreement") dated as of May 17, 1999, by and between Sea Breeze Communication Company (hereafter "SBCC") and Koch Pipeline Company, L.P. (hereafter "Koch") Koch transferred and contributed to SBCC the exclusive right to construct and operate certain telecommunication facilities within the boundaries of the easements listed on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof (hereafter the "Easements"); such transfer and contribution shall be referred to hereinafter as the "Transfer and Contribution"; and

WHEREAS, SBCC and Koch desire to provide record notice of all of the obligations of and restrictions on any third party assigns relating to the Transfer and Contribution by the recording of this Memorandum of Transfer and Contribution of Telecommunication Rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, the premises considered, notice is hereby given of such obligations and restrictions and of certain relevant terms and conditions in connection therewith, which are as follows:

1. Koch has transferred and contributed to SBCC the exclusive right to construct and operate certain telecommunication facilities within the boundaries of the Easements. Neither Koch nor its successors, assigns, licensees, lessees or other third parties acting under the color of authority granted by any of the foregoing is permitted to utilize any of the area within the boundaries of the Easements for telecommunication purposes except when such use is exclusively in connection with the easement holder's non-telecommunication business.
2. The granting of said exclusive rights does not prohibit Koch or its successors or assigns from permitting encroachments by third parties for perpendicular or near perpendicular crossings of the Easements or to such parties as may be agreed upon by Koch (or its successors or assigns), SBCC and any affected third party to whom SBCC shall have granted an Indefeasible Right To Use with respect thereto.
3. It is expressly understood that Koch and its successors and assigns have no duty to police its rights of way for or to take any actions against third parties with respect to any unpermitted encroachment or to contest any eminent domain action seeking such right.

4. SBCC recognizes and acknowledges that Koch may from time to time convey portions of the Easements to third parties. This memorandum sets forth all the obligations of and restrictions on such third-party assigns relating to the Transfer and Contribution. Koch and SBCC recognize and acknowledge that the rights of SBCC or its successors or assigns shall not include the right to install telecommunication facilities within the pipelines conveyed to such third parties that are installed pursuant to the Easements. SBCC will make commercially reasonable efforts to give reasonable advance notice to such third parties prior to the initial installation of telecommunication facilities within the boundaries the Easements, and will reasonably cooperate and coordinate with such third parties with respect to excavations affecting the Easements. SBCC and Koch both acknowledge and agree that such third-party assigns are relying on, and are entitled to rely on, the completeness and truthfulness of the matters disclosed in this Memorandum, and that if any conflict exists between the matters addressed in this Memorandum and the provisions of any document or agreement between Koch and SBCC pertaining to the Transfer and Contribution, that as to such third-party assigns, the provisions of this Memorandum shall control.




